CONFIRMATION RETREAT

April 23–25 (Fri–Sun) • \$95 for Youth or Leaders

IGNITION I

4th, 5th, 6th grades

June 6–11 (Sun–Fri) • \$270

Kids spend five nights in the cabins and six days full of swimming, crafts, Bible study and games!

GRANDPARENT CAMP I

Ages 6 and up

June 18–20 (Fri–Sun) • \$125/person

Children are invited to stay in the Center with a grandparent, and enjoy a fun-packed weekend. There will be swimming, crafts, Bible study and games, all aimed at bringing the young and the young-at-heart closer together!

FIRST TIMERS I

1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th grades

June 18–20 (Fri–Sun) • \$160

A first overnight camp experience. Spend 2 nights in the Lakeview cabins and enjoy swimming, crafts, Bible study and games!

IMPACT

9th, 10th, 11th, 12th grades

June 20–25 (Sun–Fri) • \$280 / Riverwalkers \$290

Enjoy all your camp favorites: crafts, Bible study, games, canoeing, and swimming for a whole week, while staying in the cabins. Opt for **Wilderness**, **M.A.D.**, or **Riverwalkers** on your registration form. (See descriptions below.)

Riverwalkers: Want something a little bit different from your week at camp? How about spending three days and two nights on a canoeing adventure? We will spend the week exploring the Tippecanoe River and still experience the spiritual growth that camp can bring. This adventure is not for the faint of heart, long days of canoeing and long nights of dealing with whatever nature might bring. Come ready for an awesome time on the river!!

Wilderness: If you love camp but want to rough it a little bit, Wilderness is for you! You will get to experience everything that camp has to offer, but you will be sleeping in tents and eating some of your meals cooked over an open fire. If you think that Riverwalkers is something you may want to try, this is the perfect starting place for you.

M.A.D.: Take your music, art and drama skills and use them to praise God. Stay in the cabins and experience a variety of performance and non-performance arts as you prepare a program for your family and friends on Friday night. You can go MAD with other camp activities too, such as Bible study, swimming, hiking, singing and worship around the campfire. You'll have so much fun you'll be MAD when the week's over!

DAY CAMP I

1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th grades

June 25 (Fri) 10:00am – 3:30 pm • \$35

Allow your youngest camper an opportunity to experience camp life. Spend quality time with your child while being introduced to traditional camp activities. Enjoy group Bible discussions, crafts, swimming, worship around the campfire and making new friends. Parent(s) or guardian(s) must stay for the whole day.

EPICENTER 6th, 7th, 8th grades June 27–July 2 (Sun–Fri) • \$280 / Riverwalkers \$290

The center of it all! Get ready for a week unlike any you've ever had! This awesome week will give you the opportunity to grow in faith and while having an incredible time! Activities, games, crafts, and more will erupt memories that will last a lifetime. Opt for **Wilderness, M.A.D.**, or **Riverwalkers** on your registration form.

DAY CAMP II 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, grades June 30 (Wed) 10:00am – 3:30 pm • \$35/person

A second opportunity for new campers and their parents/guardian to experience Geneva Center.

GRANDPARENT CAMP II Ages 6 and up July 5 – 7 (Mon–Wed) • \$125/person

A second opportunity to bring the young and the young-at-heart closer together!

FIRST TIMERS II 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th grades July 5– 7 (Mon–Wed) • \$160

A second opportunity for first time campers.

YOUTH LEADERSHIP CONFERENCE July 9–11 (Fri–Sun) • \$280 10th, 11th, 12th grades

Enjoy this weekend in the Lakeview cabins exploring your faith and developing leadership skills. Time will be divided between skill building with peers and leading games, nature activities, worship and singing. Take home more than just memories by using these leadership skills all year long. (Limited to teens with leadership potential, by invitation of their pastor.)

GENERAL CAMP INFORMATION

MEALS: Most meals will be served in the Dining Room of the Conference Center. Wilderness and Riverwalkers will cook some of their meals over an open fire under the supervision of our trained staff. If you or your camper have special dietary needs (including vegetarian meals, allergies, etc.), please note them on the health form.

MAIL, PHONES AND COMPUTERS: Letters from home can make your day and we encourage you to tell your parents and friends to send letters.! Letters can be mailed to Geneva Center via snail mail or e-mail at camp@genevacenter.org. Please tell everyone to address letters to you, the camper, or to put your name in the subject line of the e-mail. Sorry, we don't allow you to bring phones, computers or other electronic devices to camp. If you bring one, we will hold it for you until the end of the camp week. This is God's time. Don't worry, you'll be having so much fun you'll barely even miss your electronics. Seriously!

ARRIVAL: Registration for most of our campers will take place at the Lakeview Pavillion. However, there will be signs leading you to the appropriate drop-off spot if it's in a different location. Registration begins at 3:00 pm (Eastern Time) on the first day of camp.

DEPARTURE: Camp ends after lunch on the last day of camp. With pick up at 3PM (Eastern Time) Some camps may have a special presentation that parents are invited to attend at that time immediately before departure.

STAFF: Geneva Center takes very seriously the important role that our summer staff plays in the camp program. We strive to find highly qualified, motivated staff who desire to make a difference in the lives of our campers. All summer staff will go through an intense training to prepare them to meet the needs of our campers.

LOST AND FOUND: Please mark all of your belongings with your name for easy identification. There will be a lost and found table at departure displaying any unclaimed items from the week. All remaining items will be donated to local charities in September.

INSURANCE: Geneva Center provides initial emergency and first aid services as required. Insurance coverage is the responsibility of the camper's family.

CAMPERSHIPS: Our desire is that finances are not a factor in deciding if you can attend camp. With that in mind we do have a limited number of "camperships" (funds to help pay for the cost of your camp) available. These camperships are made possible through generous individuals and churches. If you need financial assistance, or want to contribute to the campership fund, please contact us for more information. Please note that some churches also provide financial assistance for campers to attend.

REFUNDS: Refund of camp deposit, less a \$30 processing fee, will be made if cancellation is received ten or more days prior to the beginning of camp.
